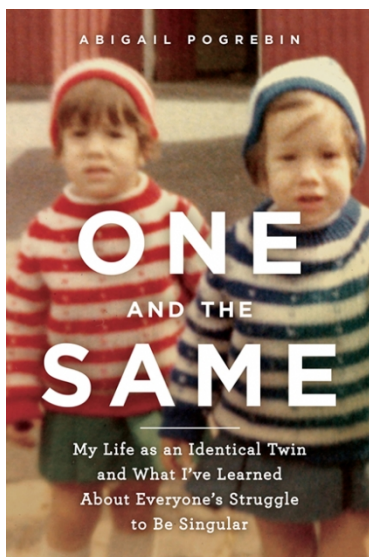


AUTHOR TALK



On **Thursday January 21 at 7:30 pm** come meet **Abigail Pogrebin** when she returns to Brotherhood Synagogue to discuss her latest book—*One and the Same*, a heartfelt and candid look at her life as an identical twin and the impact of that relationship on siblings, parents and friends...

Abigail will speak about attitudes and relationships in Jewish thought and life relating to siblings—especially twins.

Abigail Pogrebin, a Yale graduate, is the author of *Stars of David: Prominent Jews Talk about Being Jewish* (Doubleday/Broadway Books 2005), which went into eight hardcover printings. She began her career in broadcast journalism, producing for Fred W. Friendly, Charlie Rose, Bill Moyers, and then for six years at CBS News' 60 Minutes, first as a producer for Ed Bradley, then for Mike Wallace. Segueing to print journalism after her two kids were born, she became a senior correspondent for Steven Brill's *Brill's Content Magazine* and a contributor to Tina Brown's *Talk Magazine*. She has written for publications such as *New York Magazine*, the *New York Times* travel section, *Harper's Bazaar*, *Huffington Post*, *Good Housekeeping*, *Self*, *Parents*, *Salon*, *Tablet*, *The Forward*, and *Ladies Home Journal*. She has moderated several conversations at the 92nd Street Y, and will be moderating a new series at the Manhattan JCC this coming year in which she'll interview newsmakers.
